

Sunbrella Fabric

Sunbrella Solids, Textures, and Stripes

Sunbrella features a solid-and-stain-resistant finish that makes cleanup a breeze

Spot wash by sponging briskly with a solution of natural soap in lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry.

For stubborn stains or suntan lotion, use a fabric spot remover. Follow the directions on the container. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and air dry.

Solution-dyed acrylic does not promote mildew growth. However, mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. To clean mildew stains, prepare a mild solution of one-cup bleach plus two capfuls of natural soap per gallon of water. Spray on entire area and allow to soak in. If necessary, scrub vigorously with a sponge or clean rag. Sponge thoroughly with clean water and air dry.

Sunbrella Prints

Spot wash by sponging briskly with a natural soap in lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry. *Do not use bleach or harsh cleansers on prints.*

Umbrellas and Cushion Covers (Removable)

Machine wash in cold water with a mild soap then air dry.
